careers.

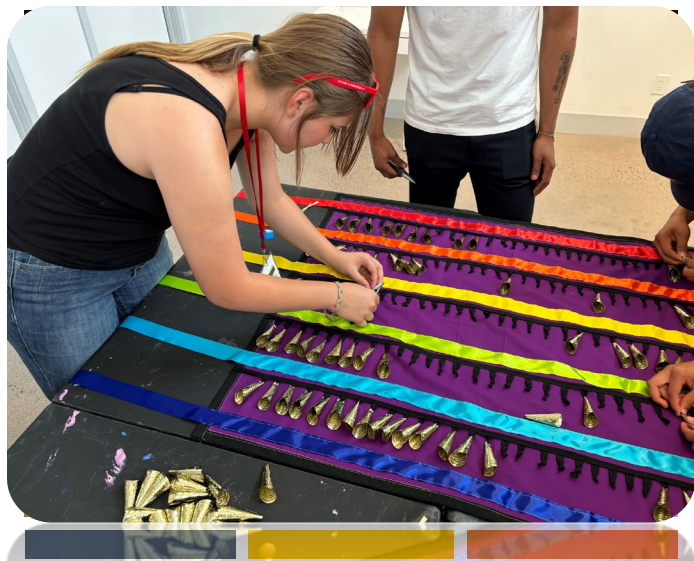
Promote educational equity and

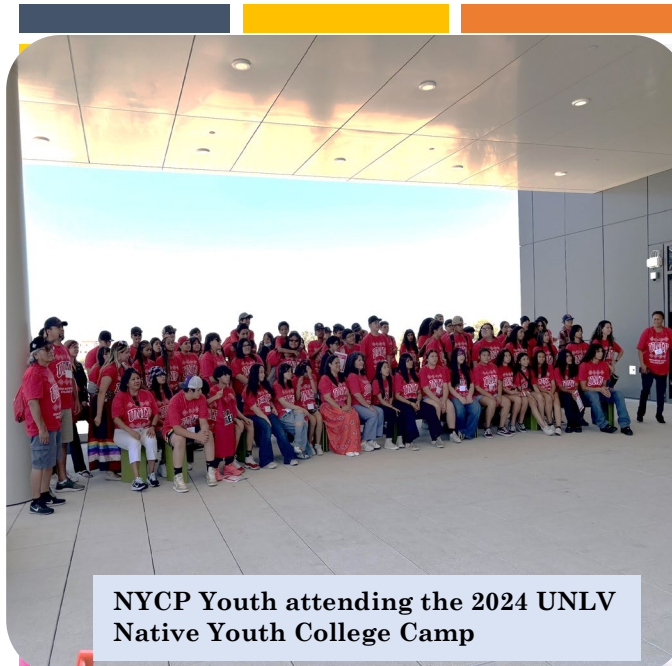


NYCP/RMC Research Data:

Documentation related to attendance, teacher training, student support services, community/family events, college tours, and career exploration will be collected. Survey data, interviews, focus group data, student achievement data, and student college and vocational training data will all be utilized to review project goals and improve the project.

New Services:

Use of College/Career Coaches to increase student motivation, and monitor grades, credit completion, and attendance in preparation for College and Careers after high school. Coaches work steadily with students individually and as a group to help them find self-sufficiency beyond their years in high school.
